A FIELD DAY WITH MAREK LANDSCAPING, LLC

Please join us for a field day exploring treated *Phragmites* blufflands and the options for habitat improvements after treatment.

The Manitowoc *Phragmites* Control Partners in conjunction with the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources is entering the second year of treatments to control the invasive *Phragmites australis* along the Lake Michigan Shoreline. MPCP has engaged Marek Landscaping to prepare stabilization and restoration plans and renderings for the re-planting of treated areas on the bluff at Fischer Creek Park in southern Manitowoc County. These plans will be used to show the range of options available to landowners that have had their blufflands treated for *Phragmites* as part of this project, and wish to use this opportunity to alter the natural process of revegetation with a planned and ecologically responsive planting and stabilization scheme.

The day will commence at 9:00 am with a presentation and site walk at Fisher Creek Park in Cleveland, WI where participants can see design alternatives. After this, staff from Marek Landscaping will go and do quick site evaluations for homeowners that desire this service. We will break into 2-3 clusters depending on the location of landowners attending the field day with north Manitowoc County, mid- County, and south Manitowoc County visits. Participants will receive an information packet and have a chance to interact directly with the experts from Marek Landscaping.
